Jesus finished the story, He asked the teacher:


"Who do you think is the hurting man's neighbor?"

Jesus always had the right answers to everyone's questions!



Jesus was satisfied with his answer because it is exactly what the scriptures teaches us.


"You have answered well." Jesus replied and then He added this:
