But that's enough explaining!


Let's start with the stories!

"Okay, wait for me, I'm coming too."


The two friends quickly walked down to the beach. They had heard about the wonderful miracles Jesus did.



A miracle is when something impossible happens. Like for very sick people all of a sudden becoming well, just by Jesus touching them or speaking to them.




Or when Jesus gave food to thousands of people with just 5 loaves of bread and two fish.
