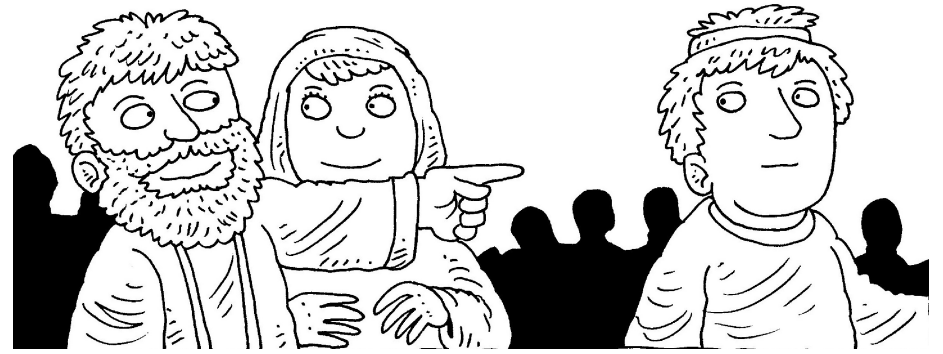
Does that sound like something which had happened in your family too? Yes, it's such a joyful time, hey!
