“But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” Is. 40:31
“Delight thyself in the Lord; and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart.”
Commit thy way unto the Lord; Trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.”
“Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him.”Ps. 37: 4-5,7
Psalm 23: The Lord is my shepherd I shall not want; He maketh me to lie down in green pastures, He leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul; He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for His names sake; Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies. Thou anointest my head with oil: my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the House of the Lord for ever.
